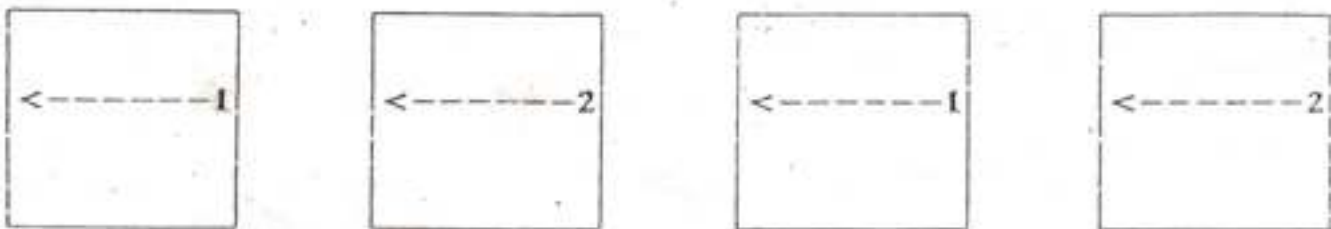

"INSTRUCTIONS FOR INSTALLATION"

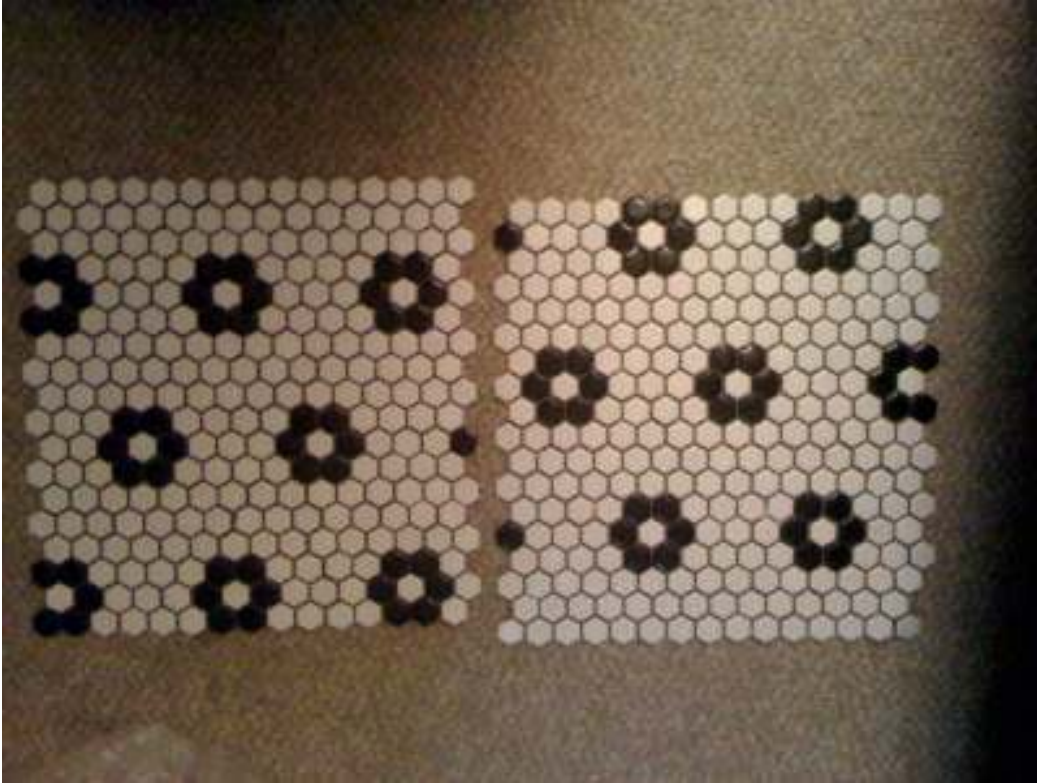
3/4 HEXAGON "FLOWER DESIGN" HEX - 30 FLOWER DESIGN



TO CREATE THE "FLOWER" DESIGN PATTERN, FOLLOW ABOVE LAY-OUT.

THERE ARE 2 DIFFERENT TYPES OF SHEETS IN EACH BOX. FOR EXAMPLE SHEET 1 WILL HAVE A PARTIAL FLOWER, I.E. $7 \frac{3}{4}$ SHEET. SHEET 2 WILL HAVE 8 FLOWERS. INSTALLER NEEDS TO PERFORM A DRY LAYOUT AND IDENTIFY WHICH SHEETS ARE WHICH FOR PROPER LAYOUT. FULL BOXES SHOULD BE ORDERED IN ORDER TO ENSURE THAT YOU HAVE ENOUGH OF EACH TYPE OF SHEET TO COMPLETE THE DESIGN.

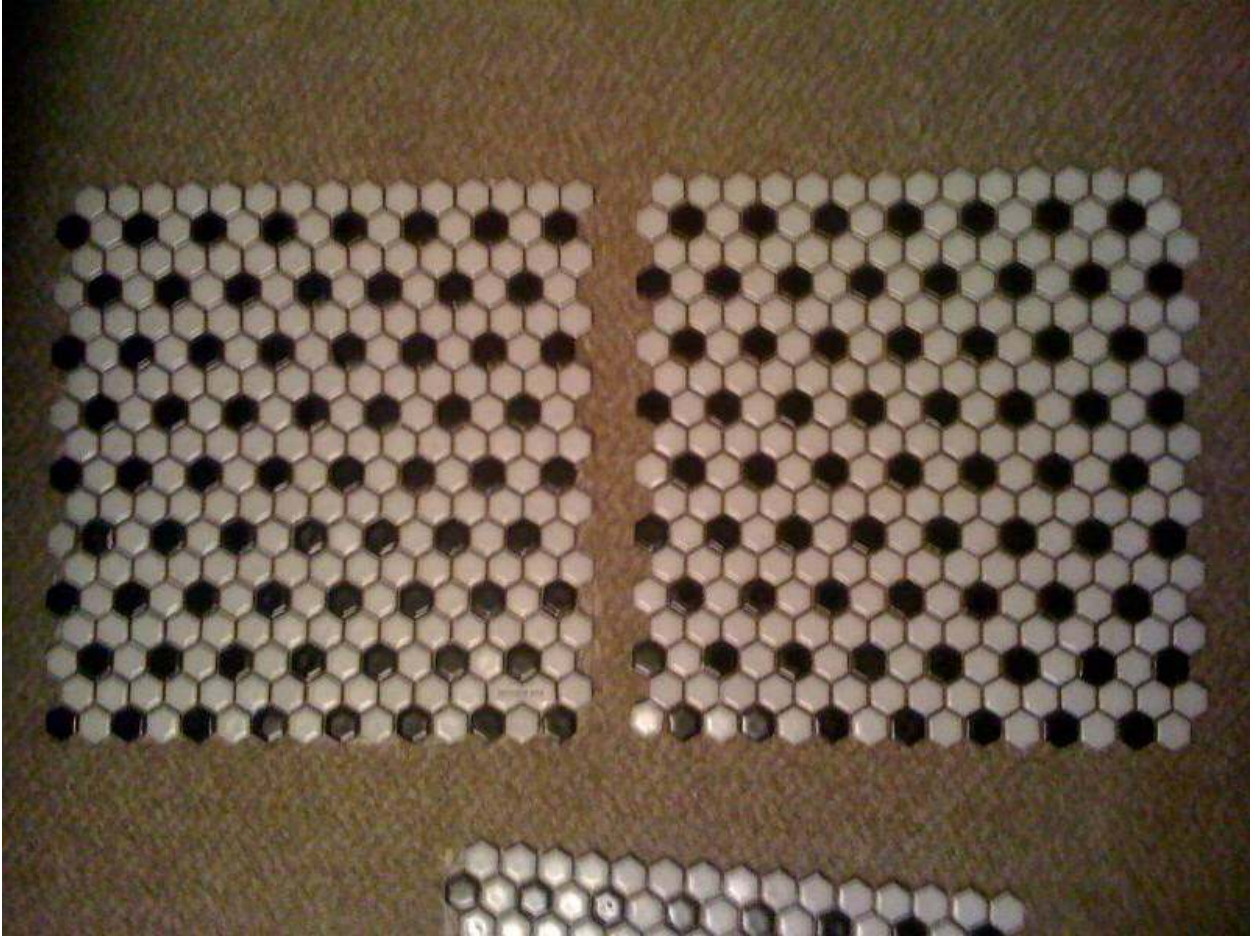
ONE SHEET WILL HAVE THE ORIENTATION IN "1" AND THE SECOND SHEET WILL BE ROTATED TO BE IN THE ORIENTATION "2" POSITION. THIS LAYOUT APPLIES TO 30M AND 50M.



IN THIS PHOTO YOU CAN SEE THE TWO DIFFERENT TYPES OF SHEETS. ONE HAS APPROXIMATELY 8 ALMOST FULL FLOWERS AND THE OTHER HAS $7\frac{3}{4}$ FLOWERS. ALSO NOTE THE BAND OF WHITE ON THE TOP RIGHT PATTERN WITH ALMOST 3 FLOWRS ACROSS AND THE OTHER PIECE HAS A WHITE BAND AT THE BOTTOM WITH ONLY 2 FLOWERS ACROSS.

HERE IS AN EXAMPLE OF AN INCORRECT LAYOUT. IT MAY NOT BE SO OBVIOUS WHEN YOU DO ONE ROW OF THE PATTERN BUT WHEN YOU COMMENCE THE SECOND ROW YOU WILL QUICKLY SEE THAT YOU MAY HAVE USED THE WRONG PIECES TO INTERLOCK.





ABOVE YOU CAN SEE FOR THE POLKA DOT HEXAGON THAT THERE ARE 2 TYPES OF PATTERNS. LOOK AT THE ONE ON THE LEFT, IT ENDS WITH A BLACK DOT ON THE BOTTOM LEFT. NOTE THE ONE ON THE RIGHT, IT ENDS WITH A WHITE DOT ON THE BOTTOM RIGHT.

HERE ARE SOME INCORRECT LAYOUTS FOR THE POLKA DOT PATTERN
